



Troy Haley is Legal Services Director for the State of Tennessee's Bureau of Workers' Compensation. He has been with the Bureau since 2007, where as a Workers' Compensation Specialist and Administrator's Designee he conducted hearings and issued determinations regarding temporary disability and medical benefits, reviewed and approved workers' compensation settlement agreements, and mediated workers' compensation disputes.
